

NOTICE OF LAST DAY OF REGISTRATION FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MAY 8, 2018

To the qualified electors of **MARENGO TOWNSHIP**
in Calhoun County, State of Michigan:

Notice is hereby given that a Special Election will be held on Tuesday, May 8, 2018. The last day on which persons may register to be eligible to vote in this Special Election is

MONDAY, APRIL 9, 2018.

Persons registering after 5:00 p.m. are not eligible to vote at said election. Registrations will be received at the following local clerk's office:

Voter registration can also be made at any Secretary of State Branch Office or renewal by mail program; government agencies such as Department of Community Health, Department of Human Services, Agencies serving disabled persons or Michigan Rehabilitation Service Offices; or visit the Calhoun County Clerk's Office in Marshall, or their web site at: www.co.calhoun.mi.us to complete and print a voter registration application to mail to your county or local clerk.

Persons entitled to be registered voters in the County of Calhoun must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the Special Election: 1) a citizen of the United States; 2) not less than 18 years of age; and 3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the Special Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the Special Election (MCL 168.497).

Qualified electors who are unable to make personal application for registration may request a mail-in voter registration application form. Completed forms must be returned to their clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. Monday, April 9, 2018, or be postmarked on or before April 9, 2018, as provided for under Public Act 441 of 1994. Persons with special needs as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the clerk's office.

The following proposal will be submitted to the Tekonsha Township electors at the Special Election to be held Tuesday, May 8, 2018:

MARENGO TOWNSHIP ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall Marengo Township impose a renewal of 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for five years, 2019 through 2023, inclusive, for township road improvement and repair purposes, which one mill increase will raise an estimated \$97,356.38 in the first year the millage is levied?
