

NOTICE OF LAST DAY OF REGISTRATION FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON AUGUST 7, 2018

To the qualified electors of the **City of Albion**
in the County of Calhoun, State of Michigan:

Notice is hereby given that a Special Election will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018. The last day on which persons may register for the election is, **MONDAY, JULY 9, 2018**. Persons registering after 5:00 p.m. are not eligible to vote at the election. Registrations will be received at the following local clerk office:

Voter registration can also be made at any Secretary of State Branch Office or renewal by mail program; government agencies such as Department of Community Health, Department of Human Services, agencies serving disabled persons or Michigan Rehabilitation Service offices; or visit the Calhoun County Clerk's Office in Marshall or their web site at www.co.calhoun.mi.us to complete and print a voter registration application to mail to your county or local clerk.

Persons entitled to be registered voters must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the Election: 1) a citizen of the United States; 2) not less than 18 years of age; and 3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.497).

Qualified electors who are unable to make personal application for registration may request a mail-in voter registration application form. Completed forms must be returned to the clerk no later than 5:00 pm Monday, July 9, 2018, or be postmarked on or before July 9, 2018, as provided for under Public Act 441 of 1994. Persons with special needs as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the clerk's office.

The following propositions will be submitted to the electors of Burlington Township at the Special Election to be held Tuesday, August 7, 2018:

ALBION CITY RECREATION MILLAGE

Shall the City of Albion increase the current levy to a total of two mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00) on taxable value of property located in the City of Albion for three years beginning with the 2019 tax levy year and running through the 2021 tax levy year (inclusive), which in the first year of such tax levy will raise an estimated revenue of One Hundred Seventy Two Thousand Dollars (\$172,000.00) used for the specific purpose of continuing operation of City of Albion recreation programs for young people, adults, families, and senior citizens? Taxes within the Downtown Development Authority (DDA) and Tax Increment Finance Authority (TIFA) districts will be distributed as prescribed by law. If approved, this would be an additional one-half increase of the current millage levy.
