

NOTICE OF LAST DAY OF REGISTRATION FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON AUGUST 7, 2018

To the qualified electors of **Burlington Township and Burlington Village**
in the County of Calhoun, State of Michigan:

Notice is hereby given that a Special Election will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018. The last day on which persons may register for the election is, **MONDAY, JULY 9, 2018**. Persons registering after 5:00 p.m. are not eligible to vote at the election. Registrations will be received at the following local clerk office:

Voter registration can also be made at any Secretary of State Branch Office or renewal by mail program; government agencies such as Department of Community Health, Department of Human Services, agencies serving disabled persons or Michigan Rehabilitation Service offices; or visit the Calhoun County Clerk's Office in Marshall or their web site at www.co.calhoun.mi.us to complete and print a voter registration application to mail to your county or local clerk.

Persons entitled to be registered voters must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the Election: 1) a citizen of the United States; 2) not less than 18 years of age; and 3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.497).

Qualified electors who are unable to make personal application for registration may request a mail-in voter registration application form. Completed forms must be returned to the clerk no later than 5:00 pm Monday, July 9, 2018, or be postmarked on or before July 9, 2018, as provided for under Public Act 441 of 1994. Persons with special needs as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the clerk's office.

The following propositions will be submitted to the electors of Burlington Township at the Special Election to be held Tuesday, August 7, 2018:

RENEWAL MILLAGE FOR TOWNSHIP FIRE OPERATING PURPOSES

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan constitution in Burlington Township, of 1 mill (\$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value) be renewed at 1 mill (\$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 4 years, 2018 through 2021 inclusive, for Township Fire Department operating purposes, raising an estimated \$47,000 in the first year the millage is levied?

BURLINGTON VILLAGE

PROPOSAL TO RESTORE AUTHORIZED OPERATING MILLAGE

Shall the authorized millage for the Village of Burlington, established at 12.5 mills (\$12.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and reduced to 9.8043 mills (\$9.8043 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be increased and restored to the original authorized millage of 12.5 mills (\$12.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), to provide funds for general operating purposes, which 2.6957 mills increase will raise an estimated \$8,899.96 in the first year the millage is levied?
