## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **Petitions submitted to Recall Albion City Precinct 5 Council Member Jeanette Spicer**

The Calhoun County Clerk-Elections Office received Recall Petition Language from Albion City Precinct 5 registered elector Daniel Farmer desiring to recall Albion City Precinct 5 Council Member Jeanette Spicer.

Michigan election law requires the County Election Commission to review the language of recall petitions before they can be circulated. The Calhoun County Clerk, County Treasurer, and the County Prosecuting Attorney will hold a Clarity/Factual Review Hearing on **Thursday, April 25<sup>th</sup>** beginning at **10:30 am** in the **Calhoun County Building** located at **315 West Green Street in Marshall**. The meeting will convene in **Boardroom 3-C08** (the Board of Commissioners Chambers on the third floor).

The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether each reason for the recall stated in the petition is factual and of sufficient clarity to enable the officer whose recall is sought and the electors to identify the course of conduct that is the basis for the recall. The hearing is NOT for the purpose of debating the merit of the allegations. The Commission does not have the authority to rule on the reasons for recall as only the clarity and factual nature of the recall language is subject to the Commission's review.
