Please take notice that the Township will be voting on the following proposal:

CLARENCE TOWNSHIP OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the limitations on general ad valorem taxes under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution now reduced from the allocated one (1.0000) mill to 0.7948 mill for said township be increased by .02052 mills (\$0.2052 per \$1,000 for taxable value) to renew and restore to one (1.0000) mill to be levied from 2019 in perpetuity for general operating purposes; and shall the township levy such increase in millage for said purpose, thereby raising the first year an estimated additional \$16,425 (this is a renewal of the allocated operating Millage)?

Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact their local township clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot.

To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instructions will be available in audio format and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting your township clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
